



Beginner and Intermediate Tajweed

Class Format

- Students will have class once a week
- Each class session consists of 25-30 minutes of individual recitation time and 30 minutes of listening to a fellow student.
- Classes are held via Skype or Zoom, based on the student's choice.

Class Schedule

- The class begins with the student reciting his/her lesson.
- The teacher will give the student the next lesson by reciting and having the student repeat.
- Through this centuries old process, the teacher helps the student to practice and correct mistakes in class.
- The student then spends time during the week practicing and perfecting the lesson taken in class.

Program of Study

This course is set up to be taken as many times as necessary, and each student progresses at his/her own pace.



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Level 1: Beginner

In this level students will recite Surah Al-Fatiha and Surah Al-Feel to Surah An-Naas.

The following Tajweed Rules will be covered in this level:

2. Ghunna on Meem and Noon Mushaddadah
3. The characteristic of Qalqalah, the degrees of Qalqalah
4. The characteristic of Hums
5. Madd Jaiz Munfasil
6. Madd Al-Leen
7. Rules of Heavy Ra

Level 2: Intermediate

Students who have completed Level 1 successfully will proceed to completing Juz 'Amma.

The following Tajweed Rules will be covered in this Level:

1. The spiritual and historical significance of the chain and transmission and the science of Tajweed.
2. Rules of Noon Sakinah and Tanween
3. Rules of Meem Sakinah
4. Rules of Laam
5. Different Categories of Idgham
6. Madd Al-Badal and Madd 'Arid Li Sukoon
7. Madd Jaiz Munfasil
8. Madd Wajib Muttasil
9. Madd Lazim Harfi and Kalimi



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Level 3: Advanced

Students in this level have already mastered the basic rules of Tajweed, and begin their journey to complete the recitation of the entire Quran. Students who complete this level with a high level of competency will be granted *ijazah* (certification) to teach others, inshaAllah.

In this level, we will cover the rules in the famous text of the *Muqaddimah Al Jazariyyah*:
